**1. Program**

**3. Technology**

- using a range of platforms, tools and media such as TV, video, radio, film, podcasts, blogs, digital social networks

The target audience for each session of the conference will be Pre-K-12 library media specialists, program officers, district supervisors, coordinators, educators and administrators.
